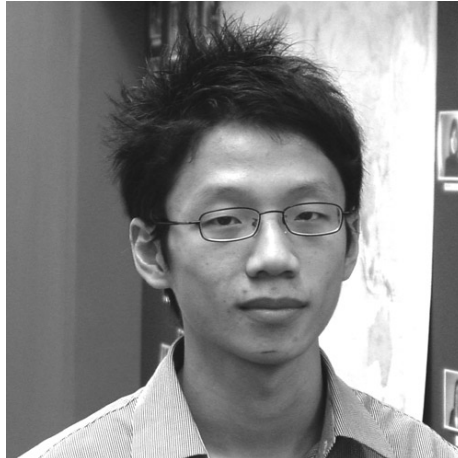


Stephen Law
